LINDENMERE FITNESS & WELLNESS CENTER



“ONE MORE SONG! ONE MORE SONG!! ONE MORE SONG!!!”


We can hear the chant in the Dining Hall. If only we could have one more song for Summer 2021!



resulted in a DQ and a Blue Outer Space win, giving them a 324 point lead going into the final day.



APPLE-CIDER DOUGHNUT CAKE!!!

If you love the Apple Cider Donuts that are often sold at Fall Festivals, you'll love this cake! Baked in a Bundt pan, it's essentially a giant cakey doughnut, made a little more wholesome with whole-wheat flour. A blend of olive oil and applesauce helps keep it moist.



INGREDIENTS

2 TABLESPOONS UNSALTED BUTTER, MELTED, PLUS MORE FOR PAN
2 CUPS UNBLEACHED ALL-PURPOSE FLOUR, PLUS MORE FOR PAN
1 CUP WHOLE-WHEAT FLOUR
1 1/2 TEASPOONS BAKING POWDER
1 1/2 TEASPOONS GROUND CINNAMON
1/2 TEASPOON BAKING SODA
3/4 TEASPOON KOSHER SALT
1 3/4 CUPS NATURAL CANE SUGAR
1 CUP APPLE CIDER
3/4 CUP EXTRA-VIRGIN OLIVE OIL
3/4 CUP UNSWEETENED APPLESAUCE
2 TEASPOONS PURE VANILLA EXTRACT
3 LARGE EGGS, ROOM TEMPERATURE


JUST A QUICK TIP. BUNDT PANS NEED TO BE GENEROUSLY BUTTERED AND FLOURED SO CAKES DON'T STICK; USE A PASTRY BRUSH TO BE SURE TO GET INTO ALL THE CREVICES.

STEPS

PREHEAT OVEN TO 350 DEGREES. BUTTER AND FLOUR A 12-CUP BUNDT PAN. IN A LARGE BOWL, WHISK TOGETHER BOTH FLOURS, BAKING POWDER, 1 TEASPOON CINNAMON, BAKING SODA, AND SALT.
IN ANOTHER BOWL, WHISK TOGETHER 1 1/2 CUPS SUGAR, CIDER, OIL, APPLESAUCE, VANILLA, AND EGGS. ADD EGG MIXTURE TO FLOUR MIXTURE; WHISK UNTIL COMBINED. TRANSFER BATTER TO PREPARED PAN.
BAKE, ROTATING PAN HALFWAY THROUGH, UNTIL A TESTER INSERTED IN THE CENTER COMES OUT CLEAN, 45 TO 50 MINUTES.
TRANSFER PAN TO A WIRE RACK SET OVER A RIMMED BAKING SHEET; LET COOL, 15 MINUTES. MEANWHILE, MIX TOGETHER REMAINING 1/4 CUP SUGAR AND 1/2 TEASPOON CINNAMON.
INVERT WARM CAKE ONTO RACK. BRUSH WITH MELTED BUTTER, THEN SPRINKLE LIBERALLY WITH CINNAMON SUGAR. LET COOL COMPLETELY BEFORE SERVING. CAKE CAN BE STORED, COVERED, AT ROOM TEMPERATURE UP TO 3 DAYS. I ALSO LOVE TO EAT THIS WITH HOMEMADE WHIPPED CREAM!!

LINDENMERE SLIME!

INGREDIENTS

½ cup clear glue

½ cup water

½ tsp Baking Soda or Bicarb. of Soda

1 - 2 tsp Contact Lens Solution Containing Boric Acid

Water color paint or food coloring

Glitter

Googly eyes, skulls or spiders....have fun here!

Mini plastic Cauldrons or specimen jars to hold the slime


Plastic wrap

Air tight container or jar for storage

INSTRUCTIONS

In a bowl add the glue and the water then mix with a spoon. Add a few drops of food coloring or water color paint and mix until combined. If adding glitter, add this now and mix once more. Add the baking soda and immediately mix until incorporated. Add the contact lens solution a little at a time as you do not want your slime to become stiff. Keep stirring until the slime comes off the sides of the bowl. This only takes a minute. Start kneading the slime and if it feels too sticky as more solution. Place the slime in the bowl and cover it, letting it sit for 5 minutes to harden slightly. Now you get to have some fun adding your
