




Senior Gamp Adventures

TASTY TOMATO SOUP & GOOEY GRILLED CHEESE!



Our Favorite Comfort Food Recipe

Every winter a favorite food on chilly days is a hot bowl of tomato soup alongside a crispy gooey grilled cheese sandwich!

Ingredients

Tomato Soup:

- 2 tbsp unsalted butter
- 2 tbsp EVOO
- 1 medium Onion (2 cups)
- 1-2 tsp Salt
- 3 Cloves of garlic, smashed and peeled
- 2 tbsp all purpose flour
- 1 Can of whole peeled tomatoes (28 oz)
- 2 Cups of low sodium stock (vegetables or Chicken)
- 2 Basil sprigs

Steps for Cooking

- Heat the oil and butter in a large saucepan over medium-high heat. Once the butter has melted add the onion, garlic and 1- 2 teaspoons of salt.
- Stir this often for about 6 to 8 minutes until ingredients are soft and golden. Stir in the flour and cook for 1 minute.
- Add the cans of tomatoes, broth and basil sprigs. Mix this together well making sure that the onion mixture is well blended with the other ingredients. Bring to a boil, then cover, reduce heat to low and simmer until the tomatoes are very soft and are breaking down, about 20 minutes.
- Take out the basil spring and let the soup cool slightly.
 Be sure to puree the soup to the consistency you like best. Serve garnished with basil leaves, freshly ground pepper and a drizzle of olive oil.

Grilled Cheese

- Bread
- Your favorite cheese!
- Butter
- Mayonnaise (if you want it)!

For the best crunchy, gooey grilled cheese, combine equal numbers of mayonnaise and butter and spread this on the outside of your slices of bread. You can even grate your favorite cheese into the sandwich as it melts better! Cook your sandwich on a medium heat and use another heavy pan to press the sandwich down onto the frying pan. This weight helps with the even transfer of heat to make a beautiful crunchy outside of your grilled cheese! YUM!!!

What do you do when not at camp?: Marketing.


How long have you been at Camp Lindenmere?: This will be my 2nd summer at Camp.


GROW YOUR OWN VEGGIES
